

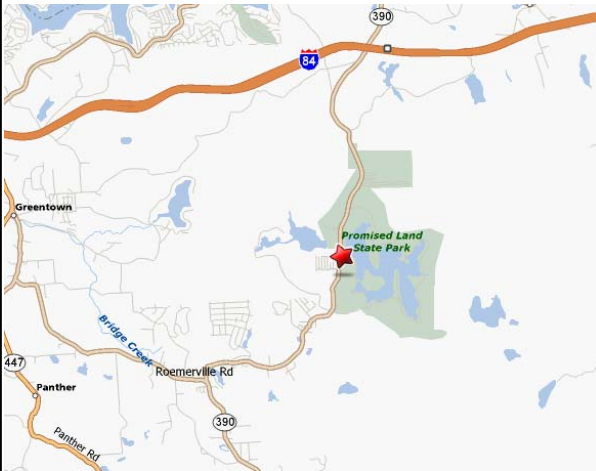
## DIRECTIONS TO PROMISED LAND FIRE HALL 1050 Rt 390, Greentown

From Scranton take I-84 to the PA 390 exit, EXIT 26, towards Promised Land State Park/Tafton. Turn right on PA 390. Travel 3.7 mi. to the Promised Land Fire Hall.

From Milford take I-84 to the PA 390 exit, EXIT 26, towards Promised Land State Park/Tafton. Turn left on PA 390. Travel 3.7 mi. to the Promised Land Fire Hall.

From Stroudsburg take PA-191 /PA-447/CREEK RD. Turn right onto PA-447/Creek Rd (9.8 mi). Turn right onto PA-390. Continue to follow PA-390 (10.9 mi.).

From Hawley take Rt 6 to the lake. Turn right onto Rt 507. Turn slight left onto PA 390 travel for 8.8 mi.
